

Volunteer Opportunities at DSA

All cash donations are tax deductible. Please make checks out to "DSA PTSA."

- **Spirit Wear Coordinator** – The PTSA sponsors a Spirit Sale three times a year. The volunteer will coordinate the sales and distribute the merchandise when it arrives.
- **Fall Fundraising Chair** – The DSA PTSA does not participate in any catalog sales. We simply send parents a letter asking for tax deductible donations. Someone is needed to compose and distribute the letter (using last year's as a template). Typically the letter is sent in early October.
- **Tutoring Breakfast Coordinator**– Breakfast is provided for students who attend free National Honor Society tutoring on Wednesdays at 7:30am. A volunteer is needed to coordinate the food and drink purchases and donations for the Wednesday morning tutoring. (You need not be present at school during tutoring.)
- **Teacher Appreciation** – We host appreciation events throughout the school year to show our teachers how valued and appreciated they are. Someone is needed to assist the Committee chairs with planning and orchestrating the events.
- **PTA Book Fair** – DSA Media Center holds a Scholastic Book Fair typically in December. We will need parents available to assist the coordinator in running the book fair.
- **School Beautification** – We need a coordinator to oversee and plan beautification projects throughout the year. These activities can be done during or after the school day or on weekends.
- **Box Tops** – We need someone who can occasionally pick them up from the office and prepare them for shipping. This is a great way to help out if you are home with younger children—they can help sort and count!
- **Loyalty Cards** – Please link your Harris Teeter, Kroger, and Target cards with DSA so we can earn free money. You can do this online or at the store. We need a coordinator to help us raise awareness and get more parents' cards linked.
